It is next submitted that during pendency of the writ application the said order of the Collector was withdrawn and the Nagar Panchayat was directed to go ahead with the process of settlement of shops but in the meantime another aggrieved person moved before this Court by filing CWJC No. 5156 of 2017 challenging the process of settlement on the ground that the land in question on which the shops are being constructed was settled as a *jalkar*.

It is thus submitted that this Court after hearing the parties of CWJC No. 5156 of 2017 had stayed the process of settlement of shops and the writ application is still pending

withdraw the present writ application with the liberty that the petitioner may be permitted to participate if steps are taken to settle the shop by the Nagar Panchayat.

Permission is accorded.
