4 03-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 366A and 376 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 6 of the POCSO Act.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that the victim, in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., has denied the prosecution case and categorically stated that no one has kidnapped her. She also stated that she voluntarily went to Delhi, as her family members were torturing her for solemnizing marriage. The victim has not alleged any wrong against this petitioner.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J. 7th cum Special Judge POCSO, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 588 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
