ORAL ORDER

3 28-04-2023 The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since title suit is pending before the learned trial Court pertaining to the subject matter of the present case, they be granted liberty to pursue their remedy before the learned trial Court. Liberty so sought is granted.

At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that some protection be granted for enabling the petitioners to seek interim orders from the learned trial Court.
