Learned counsel for the respondents points out that a provision has been added to the standing order whereby it has been notified that a complaint may be filed against the proceedings of the selection committee before the Commissioner who will examine the same and pass orders.

Keeping in view the said provision which has been brought into force with effect from 21.07.2022, the



petitioner is left free to file a complaint. If such a complaint is filed, the commissioner shall pass a speaking order giving opportunity to both the parties. The same should be decided within 60 days.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
