ORAL ORDER

2 10-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 307/34 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, all the FIR named accused persons including these petitioners, armed with pistol and iron rod, assaulted the informant on his head.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that though petitioner no. 1 & 3 are alleged to be armed with pistols, but there is no allegation of firing. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus. They have got no criminal antecedent.



Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioners, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate 1st class, Patna city in Khushrupur Police Station Case No. 307 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under sections 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
