2 11-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under sections
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Prosecution case relates to recovery of 555.5
litres of country made liquor from an open field.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and
has committed no offence. He has no concern with the
alleged recovery or with the place of occurrence. There



is no independent witness of the alleged seizure. He is languishing in judicial custody since 23.04.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with Ramkrishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 189 of 2022, Special Case No. 2151 of 2022.
