2 20-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1.That, this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ(s) / order(s) / direction (s) commanding the respondents to remove the encroachment caused by the respondents no. 5 to 9 over Khesra No. 1081 situated in village-Sirisiya Kala, Police Station-Adapur, District-East Champaran (Motihari), which has been



encroached by the respondents no. 5 to 9, which is public road and only one way of the villagers.”

The learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed a counter affidavit, which is taken on record. It is submitted that the encroachment has been found over Plot No. 1078 and not over Plot No. 1081, situated at village-Sirisiya Kala, Circle-Adapur, District-East Champaran. It is further submitted that the respondents shall take appropriate action in accordance with law.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the averments made in the counter affidavit filed in the Court today itself, hence, he submits that the present writ petition may be disposed off.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
