consequential Notice, issued by the Assistant Director,
Department of Mines and Geology, Gaya contained in Letter
No.1309 dated 26/07/16;

(ii) for quashing of the order dated 23/05/17 passed in



Rev. Case No.06/16, by The Commissioner, Department of Mines and Geology, Bihar, Patna;

(iii) for a consequential direction upon the respondents to accept the balance license fee from the petitioner and to allow him to work under License No. 138/03 granted vide Letter No. 1106 dated 31.08.03.
