2 19-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That instant writ application is being filed for issuance of an appropriate writ / writs in the nature of writ of mandamus commanding upon the respondents 1st party especially respondent no. 4 to remove encroachment in entirety over Govt. land encroached by the private respondents 2nd party in light of order / direction of Sub-Divisional Officer, Nimchak Bathani, Respondent No. 3, vide order dated 8.8.2016, contained in Annexure-2 to this writ.”



After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
