2 25-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehend his arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

There is recovery of 22 litres of foreign wine was
recovered from the house of the petitioner

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. Nothing has been recovered from the house nor the
conscious possession of petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the
petitioner has got seven criminal antecedents out of which one is
of similar nature.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has got seven



criminal antecedents out of which one is of similar nature, this application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.). Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed as not maintainable.
