2 09-05-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 354(B), 379, 436 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioners is that, he alongwith other co-accused persons abused and assaulted the informant and her family members with fists and slaps and misbehaved with the ladies. The accused persons entered into her room and took away money and ornaments and also burnt house hold articles and food grains.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.



They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He further submits that similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 07.09.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. No.5940 of 2021. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Bausi P.S. Case No.78 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
