ORAL ORDER

3 22-03-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 365, 302, 176, 177, 182, 186, 194, 196, 201, 203, 211, 212, 202 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Vide order dated 22.02.2023, a report was called for, regarding the stage of trial. In compliance thereof, a report sent by 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Purnea dated 02.03.2023, kept at flag 'R', whereby it is submitted that out of 6 prosecution witnesses, 5 witnesses have been examined and I.O. has not been examined yet and the time likely to be taken in conclusion of the trial is about three months, if parties co-operate.

Considering the submissions made in the report, I



am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner named above. The prayer for bail is hereby rejected.

Accordingly, the bail application is dismissed.

However, the trial court is directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
