2 04-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*"That the present writ petition is
being filed for issuance of writ /writs and
also for commanding the respondents to
remove the encroachment from khata
No.216, Kheshra No. 72, Tauzi No. 765,
Thana No. 342, which falls under ward
no. 39 and upon which illegally and
without any authority PCC Road has*



been constructed by the municipal corporation, Begusarai. The petitioner also prays for any other relief / reliefs for which the petitioner found to be entitled, in the facts and circumstances of the case and its the eye of law."

The learned counsel appearing for the Municipal Corporation, Begusarai has submitted, by referring to the counter affidavit filed in the present case that PCC Road has not been constructed over the private land of the petitioner, rather it has been constructed over public land.

In view of the aforesaid, I deem it fit and appropriate to dispose off the present writ petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies, as are otherwise available under the law for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
