3 03-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under section 30 (a)
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

The prosecution case relates to recovery of total
168 liters illicit mahua wine, which was recovered from a
car bearing Reg. No. JH02A-4101.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has
falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no
concern with the alleged recovery nor vehicle in question
belongs to him. It is further submitted that no any



incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 16.12.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as judicial custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Udwantnagar P.S. Case No. 510 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Judge-II, Bhojpur at Ara.
