2 09-10-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following reliefs:-

“1(i). To seize the SWIFT car bearing
Registration No. BR02P 4396 dated 23rd
March 2012 belonging to the petitioner and
hand over the same to the petitioner within
stipulated period.

(ii). For issuance of a direction to the
respondent authority to take legal action against
the respondent no.6, Ajit Kumar who has
forcefully demanded rangdari tax of Rs.2.00
lacs and due to this cause the respondent no.6



has taken away the car, now in possession of Respondent No. 6, namely, Ajit Kumar.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
