ORAL ORDER

3 18-12-2023 On 14.12.2023, the following order was passed:

“None appears for the petitioner.

2. The present matter is for restoration. Recalling order has not been placed on record. In the absence of the same, it is not possible to examine for the purpose of restoration.

3. The present MJC application is pending consideration for the last seven years, therefore, in order to give one more opportunity, relist this matter on 18.12.2023. If there is no representation, present



application would be dismissed for want of production of recalling order and so also no representation.”

2. Today also, none appears for the petitioner.

3. Perusal of the pleadings in M.J.C. Petition No.2588 of 2016 read with the order to be recalled, it is not a case for M.J.C. Petition for restoration.

4. Accordingly, the present M.J.C. Petition stands dismissed. If the petitioner intends to file litigation against the recalling of the order, he is at liberty to invoke appropriate remedy of filing Civil Review, in accordance with law.
