2 05-04-2023 Though the present writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of the notice dated 04.07.2016, issued by the Circle Officer, Ghanshyampur, but the learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners be granted liberty to approach the Circle Officer, Ghanshyampur by filing a detailed representation, whereupon the Circle Officer, Ghanshyampur be directed to dispose off the same, by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, within a stipulated



time frame.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to dispose off the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation, before the Circle Officer, Ghanshyampur, and in case such a representation is filed within a period of four weeks from today, the Circle Officer, Ghanshyampur, shall pass a reasoned and a speaking order thereon, in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks, thereafter.
