2 04-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following reliefs:-

“1(i). For directing the respondents
authorities to comply the order passed by the
competent authority under BLDR Act and
protect the land / property of the petitioner
in question.

(ii). For directing the respondent authorities
to remove the encroachment made in front



of the house of the petitioner on the land in question.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
