senior counsel for the Board, Shri Ganpati Trivedi and learned

counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset,

submits that various prayers have been made in the writ

application but he is confining his prayer only for seeking a

direction upon the respondent No. 2 to dispose of his

representation which is pending before him since 2015 as

contained in Annexure-9 to the writ application.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the Board does

not object to the prayer made by the learned counsel for the

petitioner but only with a caveat that the said direction can be



issued provided the petition, till date, may not have been disposed of.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ application is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No. 2 to dispose of the representation of the petitioner dated 26.08.2015 (Annexure-9 to the writ application) within a period of two months from the date of receipt/production of the copy of this order if not disposed of earlier.
