The learned counsel for the respondent-State has submitted, on instructions, that the encroachment in question has already been removed.

At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that if that be the case, the petitioner is not having any subsisting grievances, however, the petitioner be granted liberty to agitate his subsisting grievances by approaching the respondent authorities in case the encroachment in question resurfaces. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed off.
