Therefore, petitioner-department is hereby directed to calculate monetary benefits in the light of Sub Rule 2 of Rule 10 of Temporary Service Rules and Central Civil Services (Temporary Service Rules, 1965), (for short Rules, 1965) and the same shall be extended to the respondent within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order, along with interest @ 8% *per annum* from the date on which it was due to the respondent, in the light of Apex Court's decision in the case of *Vijay L. Mehrotra v. State of U.P.* reported in *(2001) 9 SCC 687*.

Accordingly, present writ petition stands dismissed.
