2 16-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 304(B), 201, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of ‘dowry death’.

Petitioner no. 1 is brother-in-law (*Nandosi*) and petitioner no. 2 is married sister-in-law (*Nanad*) of the deceased. Thrust of the allegation is against husband of the deceased. Police after investigation submitted final form against these petitioners. Petitioners are separate in mess & property and have got no concern with the affairs of deceased and her husband.



Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. - I, Banka in connection with Jaipur P.S. Case No. 30 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
