4 21-08-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

“2. A direction may be given to the respondents for proper inquiry and to investigate into the matter questioning from where and how Rs. 12,00,000/- was credited in A/C No. 8698633241 of Post Office Saving Bank, Dinara, Rohtas (i.e. petitioner’s account) and the same was also withdrawn without the consent or knowledge of the petitioner.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the



petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
