“That by this application, the petitioner is invoking the writ jurisdiction of this Hon’ble Court in the nature of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider for promotion to the post of Joint Secretary as petitioner is eligible for promotion to the said post of the Joint Secretary and no remarks or proceeding is pending against the petitioner.”
