3 01-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 30a/32(ii),36,41(i) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Prosecution case is that 1414.300 liters foreign liquor
was recovered from two vehicles.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is neither owner nor driver of the vehicle in
question. No incriminating material has been recovered from the
conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent of similar nature.

Considering the facts of the case, this pre-arrest bail
petition is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender within six



weeks from today, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Exclusive Special Judge, Excise, Court No. I cum Additional Sessions Judge Vaishali at Hajipur in Bidupur Police Station Case No. 674 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
