4      26-06-2023      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.  
for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner along with other family members killed the daughter of the informant on account of non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. Petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place. She has been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and



omnibus in nature. The deceased and her husband were suffering from AIDS, due to which she committed suicide. It is further submitted that the similarly situated co-accused, namely, Munna Kumar Sah, who is husband of the deceased, has been enlarged on bail by this court vide order dated 22.06.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 14722 of 2023. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as there is no specific overt act against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 274 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
