following relief(s):-

*“1. That this writ application on behalf of the  
petitioner aforesaid is directed for issuance of  
appropriate writ(s), order(s), direction(s)  
preferably in the nature of Mandamus for  
commanding the respondent to cancel the  
appointment of respondent no.7 from the post of
