2 25-04-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 188, 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 326, 307, 332, 333, 353, 379, 337, 338, 290, 427, 171(C), 171(H) of the Indian Penal Code and 126 of R.P. Act.

The petitioner in association with other co-accused persons is said to have attacked on the police party causing injuries to them.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and



omnibus in nature. He further submits that several similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court as well as by co-ordinate Benches of this Court. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No.299 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
