The Public Interest Litigation is filed for a direction to the respondents to constitute a Managing Committee according to the Rules and Regulations laid down by the Bihar School Examination Board, to direct production of the procedure initiated and continued for constitution of such Managing



Committee and to enquire into whether such a Managing Committee has been constituted or not. The petitioner also has another prayer to include the name of the donor of the land of the school in the Managing Committee of Shiv Ratan High School, Jaru Banvariya, Hulasganj (Jehanabad).

The learned State Counsel submits that a Managing Committee has already been constituted which is also impleaded as 7th respondent. We do not think there is any public interest in so far as the prayers are concerned, especially that of inclusion of name of the donor of the land in the school’s name. We find no reason to invoke our extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226, especially in the present petition styled as a Public Interest Litigation where no such public interest exists.

The writ petition would stand dismissed.
