2 15-05-2023 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 342, 506, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per prosecution case, these petitioners assaulted on the head of the mother of the informant by means of *lathi*.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that there is no allegation of overt act against petitioner No. 1 and injury caused by petitioner No. 2 is simple



in nature. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VI, Gaya in connection with Tekari P. S. Case No. 492 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
