ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case

3. Petitioner, who is husband of opposite party

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the



week of every succeeding month in the bank account of opposite party no.2 as per the details furnished by her counsel.

5. In that view of the matter, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No.1825C of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.,

6. It goes without saying that the aforesaid payment shall be subject to any order being passed in matrimonial, maintenance or any other collateral proceedings.

7. The present order, in any way, will preclude the parties to resolve the issue otherwise.

8. It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to make payment on three consecutive dates, the learned court below will be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

9. Accordingly, this application stands disposed of.
