2 16-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354, 504, 506 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per F.I.R., petitioner no. 1 is alleged to have assaulted the informant with Khanti and petitioner no. 2 is said to have caught hold of the informant.

There is case and counter case and both sides sustained injury. Injuries caused by petitioners are simple in nature. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad in connection with Deo P.S. Case No. 236 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
