ORAL ORDER

2 28-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner rather 13.500 liters of Nepali country made liquor is said to have been recovered from the motorcycle. He submits that the petitioner is not the owner of the said motorcycle. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent of similar nature as mentioned in para-3 of this application.



Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs.20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand) in the account of Patna High Court Legal Services Committee, Patna, bearing Account No.1413010060836, IFSC Code: PUNB141320, Punjab National Bank, Bar Council Branch, Patna.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Jaynagar P.S. Case No. 474 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C, subject to the further conditions that

(1) One of the bailors will be her own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or her husband.

(2) The petitioner shall not indulge herself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit of the



aforesaid amount in the account of Patna High Court Legal
Services Committee, Patna.
