2 29-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioners have filed the instant application

for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 302, 120(B) of the

Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioners along

with other co-accused being the in-laws, committed

murder of the informant's daughter, namely, Rubi

Kumari.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the



petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and they have committed no offence. Being the father-in-law and brother-in-law of the deceased, they have falsely been implicated in the present case. They have no concern with the mess and business of the deceased as well as her husband. There is no specific overt act of allegation against the petitioners. It is further submitted that husband of the deceased, namely, Sugrim Ram is already in judicial custody. Moreover, the petitioners are languishing in judicial custody about ten months. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged



on bail in connection with Bikramganj P.S. Case No. 225
of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees
ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount
each to the satisfaction of the learned XIX Additional
Sessions Judge, Rohtas, Sasaram.
