In view of the law laid down in the cases of **State Bank of Travancore & Anr. Vs. Mathew K.C.** reported in **2018(3) SCC 85**, **ICICI Bank Limited & Ors. Vs. Umakanta Mohapatra & Ors.**, reported in **2019(13) SCC 497** and also **C. Bright Vs. District Collector & Ors.**, reported in **2021(2) SCC 392**, the present writ petition is not maintainable with regard to issues involved in the present petition of bank initiating a proceeding under the SARFACIE Act.

As such, the present petition is dismissed as not



maintainable. However, the same shall not come in the way of the petitioner to approach the correct forum, namely D.R.T for seeking his reliefs.
