State.

2. This writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to make payment of compensation for the acquired land according to the new Land Acquisition Act, 2013, which is applicable in case of acquired land of the petitioner.

3 . It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after receiving the notice, he has already filed an application on 5th December 2015 for fixing compensation, as



per new Land Acquisition Act, 2013 , before the respondent No. 5 (The Collector, Bhagalpur, District–Bhagalpur) but the same has not been disposed of and is still pending for disposal. Accordingly, he requests for directing the concerned respondent to dispose of the application filed by the petitioner.

4. In view of the prayer made on behalf of the petitioner as well as the facts and circumstances of the case, the writ application is disposed of with direction to the concerned respondent, i.e., respondent no. 5 (the Collector, Bhagalpur, District-Bhagalpur), to dispose of the application of the petitioner, in accordance with law after hearing all the parties, preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt/production of the representation.

5 . The writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction.
