following relief:-

*“That the present writ petition is
being filed for challenging the order dated
12.01.2023 passed by Chief Engineer Rural
Works Department to debar the petitioner
from the work with saying that the petitioner
has not completed the work within time and
he has not filled reply of so cause and due to
which he has been declared as defaulter and
debar from the work of the department, the*



real fact is that the petitioner has filed an application before Executive Engineer Rural Works Department Pupri to revise the estimate on 14.12.2022 that has not been considered and the order for debarring the petitioner has been passed without considering the application filled by petitioner and without revising the estimate which is against the law and it may be set aside and pass appropriate order according to law as per principle of natural justice.”

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition. Such statement is taken on record.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn reserving liberty to the petitioner to invoke remedy before appropriate forum.
