2 27-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner has filed the instant application

for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 452,

380, 353, 376, 511, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code

and Section 3/4 of Witchcraft prevention Act.

It is a case of outraging the modesty of

complainant and assaulting to complainant and her



mother by petitioner and other co-accused persons and calling her witch.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. There is admitted land dispute between the parties. There is an inordinate delay of 3 days in lodging the case. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 07.12.2022. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Complaint case No. 606 of 2006 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to
the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Aurangabad.
