A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 8 and 10 of the POCSO Act.

As per the prosecution case, the informant alleged that his sister, On the point of pistol, was kidnapped by the accused persons and two unknown persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioners have



been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that the police has submitted final form against the petitioners but the learned court below differed the final form and took cognizance against the petitioners. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No.74 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
