counsel for the State.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
M.J.C. No.4664 of 2018 stood dismissed for default for non-
compliance of the peremptory order dated 11.09.2019 passed in
M.J.C. No.4664 of 2018, whereby ten days' time was granted to
the petitioner for removing the defects.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he
complied the orders of the Court dated 11.09.2019, but little
belatedly.

Since it has been submitted that the defect, as pointed
