2 29-04-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehend his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304(B), 120(B), 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner, who is the father-in-law of the deceased is said to have killed the daughter of informant, in association with his family members on the pretext of non-fulfillment of demand for dowry.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. Petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased



and there is no specific overt act against him. The husband of the deceased is already in judicial custody, which is also mentioned in para-12 of the bail application. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Mali P.S. Case No.112 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
