State.

Petitioner apprehend their arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under sections 498 (A)/ 304 (B)/ 34
of the Indian Penal Cod & $\frac{3}{4}$ of the D.P. Act.

It is a case of dowry death.

Petitioner is mother-in-law informant's daughter
(deceased).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. It is further submitted that the petitioner is separate in
mess and business. Thrust of allegation is against the husband of
the deceased who is already in custody. Petitioner claims clean
antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M, West Muzaffarpur in connection with Kanti P.S. Case No. 398 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
