application (Annexure-10 series) before the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum- Vice Chairman District Water and Swachchata Committee (DWSC) Gogalpanj, (Respondent no.4) seeking general direction for conducting the affairs of the *Panchayat* and making selection according to law. The writ application does not raise any specific relief which can be granted to the petitioner. The writ application has also not been filed as a PIL.
