for the State.

The petitioner has filed the present writ application to conclude the investigation in connection with Darbhanga Mahila P.S. Case No. 101 of 2018 registered under Sections 376/120B of the I.P.C. read with Section 4/6 of the POCSO Act and further he needs that immediate action be taken against the accused persons (Respondent No.4-6) who are F.I.R. named

accused persons.

Learned counsel for the State submits that it is a case of 2018 and if investigation has not been completed then, it is a serious issue.

In this view of the matter, petitioner may be directed to represent before the Superintendent of Police, Darbhanga in the light of *Surendra Singh Vs. State of Bihar* passed in *Cr.WJC No. 153 of 2017* decided on 09.09.2022.

In this view of the matter, this writ petition is **disposed of**, directing the petitioner to represent before the Superintendent of Police within 4 weeks and he is directed to take proper action in the light of above mentioned case.

With this observation, this writ application is hereby disposed of.
