2 09-10-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(i). For issuance of appropriate



order/orders, writ / writs, direction/directions in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notices dated 12.02.2022 issued by the Circle Officer, Minapur in Encroachment Case no- 14 of 2021-22.

(ii) For further issuance of appropriate writ/writs, direction/ directions, order/ orders in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent No. 2 for issuance of settlement of the land situated in Mauza-Prasad, under Gram Pranchayat Raj Piprahan Asali bearing Khata No. 118, Kheshra No. 626 in favour of the petitioners on the ground that the petitioners are landless persons and they have no land for residing themselves and they are below the poverty line.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur, for the purposes of settlement of the land in question. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
