ORAL ORDER

3 16-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 63/65 of the Copy Right Act and Section 103/104 of the Trade Act.

As per FIR, informant alleged that the petitioner used to trade duplicate articles in the name of his company. It is further alleged that petitioner was apprehended on the spot and several articles were seized from the house of the petitioner, after that this case has been lodged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has



falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery rather house in question is a joint house of the petitioner. He has got no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the provision of u/s 100 has not been followed during preparation of seizure list. The petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 15.10.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Bairgania P.S. Case No. 301 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi.
