A.P.P. for the State.

The present application has been filed for
modification of the order dated 16.03.2018, passed in Cr. Misc.
No. 5159 of 2018, by which the petitioner was granted
anticipatory bail in connection with Complaint Case No. 2722
of 2016, corresponding to Trial No. 1756 of 2017, pending in
the court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XII,
Saran at Chapra, and the petitioner was directed to surrender in
the court below within a period of six weeks.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioner could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is further submitted that further time may be extended so that the petitioner could surrender in the court below.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the period of surrender of the petitioner in the court below is extended for a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 16.03.2018, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 5159 of 2018, is modified to the extent as indicated above.

The present application is disposed of.
