counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Complaint Case No. 1204C of 2016 registered for the offences
under Section 420, 406, 323, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
instant case. Further submission is that both the parties have
compromised the alleged dispute as contained in Annexure-2.
Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
