Admittedly, an appeal in terms of and under the provisions of Section 7- I of the Employees' Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1952'), is provided to challenge an order passed under Section 14 B of the Act of 1952. However, the petitioner has challenged the same before this Court. The order passed under Section 7-Q of the Act of 1952 is also even dated. Although, there is no mention of an appeal lying against the order passed under Section 7-Q of the Act of 1952 before the Appellate Authority. Since the same is a consequential order



both the orders dated 21.11.2022 passed under Section 14 B of the Act of 1952 and under Section 7- Q of the Act of 1952 can be examined while hearing the appeal against an order under Section 14 B of the Act of 1952.

Leaving the petitioner to take up the remedy before the Appellate Authority, the writ petition stands disposed of.
