the petitioners successfully
completed the running test and
officer deputed on the field also
declared pass but later on the*



petitioner declared fail for which the petitioner also filed representation on 20.12.2021 (Annexure-1) which is pending for disposal.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
